

Determining Installed Software Versions

Most all of your software versions can be determined from the “Help” menu on Windows based computers or the “ApplicationName” menu on Macs. These menu options should have an “About ApplicationName” option in them, which will report the current version. However there are two commonly installed software packages (Sun Java and Adobe Flash Player) that do not follow this standard. Below you will find links that will determine if and which versions of these programs you have installed.
