There is a strong chance that Apple's iTunes account security has been compromised. Therefore if you are an iTunes store user then you might want to change your iTunes password. Steps to change your iTunes password:

1. Launch iTunes.
2. Select the "Sign In..." option from the "Store" menu.
3. Sign in with your current ID and password.
4. Select the "View My Account" option from the "Store" menu.
5. Provide your password again and click on the "View Account" button.
6. Click on the "Edit Account Info" button.
7. Change your password being sure to verify it and click on the "Done" button.
8. Select the "Sign Out" option from the "Store" menu.
9. Done.
