This message is for Windows users only! Microsoft has just announced and patched multiple “Extremely Critical” security vulnerabilities in their Internet Explorer program. Windows 7: (will require a restart)

1. Click on the Windows logo button (the old Start button from XP).
2. Click on the “All Programs” menu option.
3. Click on the “Windows Update” menu option.
4. Click on “Check for updates” on the left side of the window that appears.
5. Once it’s done checking for updates click on the “Install updates” button.
6. Restart your computer when prompted.

Windows XP: (will require a restart)

1. Select the “Windows Update” menu option from the “start” menu.
2. Click on the “Express” button in Internet Explorer.
3. Click on the “Install Updates” once it’s done checking.
4. Restart your computer when prompted.

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
