Google has announced and patched six “Highly Critical” vulnerabilities in their Chrome web browser application. This is not a browser that many of you will have installed on your computers since we don’t install it on new installs nor do we directly support it. However, if you have manually installed it on your own and are using it as your default web browser then you should go to [www.google.com/chrome](http://www.google.com/chrome) and download the latest version ASAP.
