Apple has just announced 46 “Highly Critical” vulnerabilities in their 4.x version of Safari Browser. There isn’t a patch for the 4.x version but Apple has released version 5 so all you Mac users out there should to do a “Software Update...” from the Apple menu ASAP. This update will require a restart of your computer. Apple has also released version 5 for windows so if you are running Safari as your browser on your Windows box (which most of you are not) then you should go to <http://www.apple.com/safari/> and download the latest version.
