Hello CNRE,

Mozilla has patched some “Highly Critical” vulnerabilities in the 3.6.x version of their Firefox browser application. This affects both Windows and OS X so **ALL Firefox users should update ASAP!** It should only take about a minute and will not require a restart of your computer. If you are unsure if you have Firefox installed look for a “Mozilla Firefox” folder in your Programs listing under the “Start” button in Windows or look for “Firefox.app” in your “Applications” folder on the Mac. To update your Firefox application simply start Firefox, select the “Check for Updates...” option from the “Help” menu, and install any update that it displays. If it doesn’t find any updates then you are either running a non-affected version or Firefox already updated itself. If you do not have the “Check for Updates...” option under the “Help” menu then [contact us](#) for further instructions.
