Hello CNRE,

Apple has just announced and patched four "Highly Critical" vulnerabilities in their iTunes package. Both the OS X and Windows versions are affected. All Mac users should perform a "Software Update..." from the Apple menu ASAP and install any updates that it recommends. For the Windows users out there CNRE-IT does not install iTunes by default so you only have to worry about this if you have installed it yourself at some time. If you are an iTunes user in Windows then perform a "Apple Software Update" from the Start menu and install any "Updates" that it finds. Note that neither of these versions will require a restart of your computer. Thanks and as always please do not hesitate to [contact us](#) for problems or questions. Lon.
