Hello yet again CNRE,

Apple has just announced and released a patch for 7 highly critical vulnerabilities in some of the iDevice line of products. These include the iPad, iPhone, and the iTouch. I have yet to try this with my iTouch since mine syncs with my home computer but am assuming that doing a sync with iTunes will make the update available. I will try updating mine tonight so if you have any questions I should have more insight on the updating process tomorrow. For more information on this vulnerability see either of the links below.
