Hello CNR,

Mozilla has just patched eight “Highly Critical” vulnerabilities in their Firefox browser application. There are currently three versions of Firefox (3.x, 3.5.x, & 3.6.x) and all three are susceptible to the these vulnerabilities. **Mozilla in only patching the 3.6.x version therefore all Firefox users need to update to the 3.6.x version ASAP!** Follow the appropriate link below to download the version for your OS, double-click on the downloaded file, and follow the on screen instructions to complete the install. When you’re done you should be at version 3.6.2.
