Hello yet again CNRE,

This is just a heads up that there is an unpatched “Extremely Critical” vulnerability in Adobe’s Reader and Acrobat applications. This has a 0-day rating which is as bad as it gets and means that it is actively being exploited! All you have to do is open a malformed PDF attachment or click on a PDF web link and your computer could potentially be taken over. Adobe has yet to release a patch for this vulnerability so the only protection you have at this point is to be careful when opening PDF’s. Remember **NEVER** open unknown or unsolicited PDF attachments or click on PDF links on web pages that are not trusted or known.
