**Importance:** High

Hello CNR,

Apple has announced an **unpatched** "Highly Critical" vulnerability in their Safari web browser for Windows application. Simply closing a pop-up window from a malicious website can allow your computer to be compromised! **Therefore if you are a Safari for Windows user then I strongly recommend not using it until this is patched!** Luckily this will not affect most of you since Internet Explorer and Mozilla Firefox seem to be the prevalent web browsers of choice in our college.
